Each board has a rotating schedule with at least $1/3^{\rm rd}$ of the board rotating off each year. The boards meet via conference call on a quarterly basis and in person at least once per year. Board members are expected to dedicate 2-4 hours per month towards their Advisory Board.

Board terms are a one (1) year initial term with a two (2) year extension option. Board members who are active contributors will be automatically granted a two (2) year extension serving a full three (3) year term.

Eligibility

To be eligible to serve on an ASI Advisory Board, the candidate must:

- be actively employed by an ASI member firm
- have three (3) years experience (employment) in the industry
- have a proven track record of success in the industry
- obtain a recommendation from top management within their firm
 - o only principals, or those acting as the principal, can serve on the ASI Advisory Board
- distributor firms must have a credit score of 80, or better
- supplier firms must have a supplier rating of four (4) stars, or better.
