Hello,

As you know, this summer, on August 4th, I was rushed to Children's Hospital where I was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes. When I was told I had diabetes, I was surprised, shocked, sad and confused – I had never felt this way. I didn't do any thing to cause my pancreas to stop making insulin. Although, I knew about diabetes because my older sister, Sydney, was diagnosed when she was 7, I didn't want to get the shots and have to do all the stuff my sister does.

It is so hard having diabetes because it is all very painful inside and out. It is hard to feel the way you want to feel because your blood sugar can go high or low just by what you eat or do. I have to test my blood sugar ten times a day by pricking my finger and that hurts. They say I will get used to it but I haven't yet. I am on a pump and have to get a new site in my body every three days – that hurts too. And wearing a pump all the time is tricky especially when you are trying to get dressed. The hardest part is I never get a break from having diabetes.

Today, I am writing to you because I want to find a cure. There are millions of other kids like me and my sister. We want a cure so we can be just like regular kids again without diabetes.

Once again, I have joined the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation's Walk for a Cure in Philadelphia this October 26th. Last year my sister and I co-captained a walk team called Sydney's Super Stars. With the help of many friends and family, we became the number one walk team in the nation and raised over \$400,000.00. This year I am captaining my own team called Mackenzie's Miracle Makers – it is still the same team but I get to have my own logo☺. We are hoping for a great turn out - I hope you will come walk with me. Bring your friends, siblings, parents and even dogs. It will be a lot of fun.

My parents say research is the answer and that in my life time, scientists will find a cure for me, my sister, and all the other children with diabetes. But they need our help to raise money and awareness. That is why it is so important to walk on October 26th. We will start gathering across from the Art Museum steps at 9am.
